I. Jewelry

The bronze Amelia Earhart medallion is reserved for AEMSF winners.

The interlocking 99s jewelry is authorized to have a stone in the center of the propeller, designating the office that is currently or formerly held.

Ruby	Chapter Chairman
Emerald	Section Governor
Sapphire	Life Member
Diamond	Formerly for Charter Members – now International President and Emeritus (Our last charter member went to New Horizons in September 2004)

When the interlocking 9s are used in a ring, it is recommended that the 9s face outwardly, so that others can read the numbers when the hand is extended.

II. Use of Official Stationery

A Board member may affix her signature to a letter on official stationery using her title as a member of the Board, as long as the letter's content is not in violation of the Articles of Incorporation and the Bylaws.

Headquarters shall provide stationery template files with The 99s logo and instructions for adding files to the computers of new Board members if requested.
